An international and national tour veteran, Matt also toured with Canadian jazz supergroup Four80East and he teamed up with Marcus Anderson (Prince's saxophonist) for many live shows. You can also catch him strumming at clubs such as Yoshi's in San Francisco, Scullers in Boston and many other respected venues nationwide.

Inspired keyboardist, composer, studio musician and producer, **Brian Simpson's** multiple talents are revered for his unparalleled ability to compose unforgettable melodies and irresistible grooves. His knack for blending genres and churning out timeless anthems coupled with his soulful approach to music has resulted in collaborations with Janet Jackson, Teena Marie, George Duke, Stanley Clarke and Dave Koz, for whom he has served as musical director for nearly two decades.
