
COMMUNITY REPORT

MetroWest benefits from public safety partnership

In 2018, MetroWest marked the fifth year of our community partnership with Critical Intervention Services (CIS), a Florida based company that specializes in enhancing public safety. MetroWest Public Safety Officers (PSO) serve as community liaisons, building relationships with community members, businesses, the Orlando Police Department (OPD), and other law enforcement officials and entities.

Over the past year, MetroWest PSOs were involved in more than 16,000 community contacts within MetroWest, a clear indication that the program is unifying residents and businesses to promote the highest standards of public safety.

Also in 2018, MWMA and CIS continued to facilitate the process by which MetroWest communities can implement the principles of Crime Prevention through Environmental Design (CPTED) in order to achieve Crime Free Certification from OPD. In June, eight MetroWest communities were recognized and congratulated for having received Crime Free Certification.

We envision continued success in 2019 and appreciate the efforts of all our neighbors who strive to ensure the safety of MetroWest residents, businesses and visitors.





Special events strengthen community bonds





Fun community events have become a tradition in MetroWest and in 2018 our special events grew in appeal and attracted thousands of attendees.

The new, monthly MetroWest FoodTruck Connection has been a great success after being reinvented and relaunched in January 2018. The FoodTruck Connection

has been enhanced with new and exciting food vendors, music and family fun activities.

In May, MetroWest MusicFest drew nearly 1,000 attendees who braved predictions of lessthan-ideal weather to enjoy an afternoon at MetroWest Golf Club filled with live music from a variety of talented performers.

In December, more than 5,000 attendees joined us to kick-off the holidays at the 7th Annual WinterFest. The free, family event included the movie "Happy Feet" shown on a big screen on the MetroWest Golf green, an ice skating rink, photos with Santa and Mrs. Claus, and performances by local artists. Santa and his elves arrived

by parachute this year, much to the delight of hundreds of children in attendance.

Other successful MetroWest events in 2018 included National Night Out and the annual RealtorTour. More than 1,500 attendees enjoyed the annual National Night Out event, which helps increase Neighborhood Watch participation and make our neighborhoods safer. The
